



A. INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE SESSIONS

Honoraria

Honoraria are not provided for participation in Conference sessions.

Speaker Registration Fees

ATS Members: ATS members will pay the member General Registration fee and fees for all courses, seminars and workshops accordingly.

Non-Members: Non-ATS members invited to participate in the International Conference sessions listed below may register one of two ways as follows:

- **One-Day Complimentary Pass:** registration for the day of your presentation. This allows access to the Conference for one day only; attendance on other days is not permitted. Speakers wishing to register for courses, seminars and/or workshops scheduled for that day will be expected to pay respective fees accordingly.
- **General Conference Registration:** Non-member speakers wishing to attend 2 or more days of the Conference must register for the entire Conference and pay a discounted non-member General Registration Fee. Speakers wishing to register for courses, seminars and/or workshops will be expected to also pay respective fees accordingly.

Reimbursement

Only non-ATS members whose expenses are not covered from other sources are eligible for the reimbursement of travel/hotel expenses in relation to participation in the session formats listed below as follows:

SCIENTIFIC SYMPOSIA, CLINICAL TOPICS IN PULMONARY MEDICINE, CRITICAL CARE TRACK, YEAR IN REVIEW

Up to two (2) non-member speakers may be reimbursed per session.

WORKSHOPS

One (1) non-member speaker may be reimbursed per workshop.

ABSTRACT SESSIONS

Featured speakers in Mini Symposia should be ATS members or speakers already participating on the program in major sessions. There is a limited budget to be shared by all Assemblies for the reimbursement of featured speakers who are non-ATS members if the needed expertise for the session cannot be found within the membership.

Chairs and facilitators of abstract sessions are not reimbursed for expenses.

Abstract authors presenting at the abstract sessions are not reimbursed for expenses.



INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE REIMBURSEMENT POLICY

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SUNRISE SEMINARS AND MEET THE PROFESSOR SEMINARS

Sunrise Seminar and Meet the Professor Seminar presenters are not reimbursed for expenses.

THEMATIC SEMINAR SERIES

Thematic Seminar Series presenters are not reimbursed for expenses.

The ATS has a limited budget for the reimbursement of non-member speakers; therefore, each speaker requiring reimbursement must be approved by ATS prior to the Conference.

Preliminary invitations are made by appropriate members of the International Conference Committee at which time information on expense guidelines should be provided. The formal confirmation and arrangements for expenses will be provided in a follow-up letter from the International Conference Committee Chair.

Speakers approved for reimbursement must follow the Reimbursement Guidelines when submitting expenses. Speakers from North America (including Canada) will be reimbursed up to \$1,000 US. Speakers from outside North America will be reimbursed up to \$2,000 US.

B. POSTGRADUATE COURSES

Postgraduate courses are held immediately preceding the Conference and should be self-supporting. Registration fees will be set accordingly by the ATS Executive Office.

All faculty will be reimbursed for hotel and meal expenses for 1 or 2 days in relation to participation in the course. Non-ATS members will also be reimbursed for travel expenses. ATS members not attending the Conference may also be reimbursed for travel expenses.

All Postgraduate Course faculty wishing to attend the International Conference must register and pay fees accordingly.

Honoraria are provided, income permitting, for postgraduate course faculty who have provided the course book material and made the presentation.

Speakers must follow the Reimbursement Guidelines when submitting expenses.
