CME Credits and MOC Points

Instructions for Claiming CME Credit:

You will be able to **evaluate and claim CME credit from now until July 5, 2023** via our evaluation portal accessed via this QR code:



OR this site: <u>ATS 2023 International Conference</u> (xpressreg.net)

To claim CME credit, complete these three steps:

- Attend the CME-eligible activity. The designation of AMA PRA Category 1 Credits™ is listed in the conference program for applicable sessions. To view the conference
- **Instructions for Claiming MOC Points:**

Although the pre-test is closed, all is not lost! Feel free to attend as many MOC designated courses as possible to earn the maximum number of MOC points! The pre-test is great but **optional**.

To claim MOC, complete these steps:

- During ATS 2023: Attend any MOC designated symposia you are interested in. Except for one Post-Graduate Course, advance registration is not required.
- 2. Follow the steps to claim CME credit as listed above- the link to the site is the same as above!

- 2. Submit a short evaluation for each session(s) for which you desire credit. Attendance alone is not sufficient.
- 3. Complete a short ATS Conference-wide evaluation.
- 4. Attest to the credits earned through the activity and print your certificate. Don't forget to save or email yourself a PDF of your certificates for your records.

3. **After ATS 2023**: Take the knowledge-based posttest. Posttests for all MOC-eligible symposia will be available at on May 24, 2023, 5 pm ET and attendees can take the tests at no additional cost through Wednesday, July 5th 11:59 PM ET.

Note: Submitting answers through the ARS (Audience Response System) during a session does not count as completing the posttest. Also, completing to steps to claim just the CME credits will not automatically grant you MOC points. You must complete the CME session evaluation AND pass the MOC posttest to earn MOC.
