

CME Credits and MOC Points for ATS 2025

INSTRUCTIONS FOR CLAIMING CME CREDIT:

You will be able to **evaluate and claim CME credit from now until Friday, June 27, 2025** via our evaluation portal - <u>https://www.xpressreg.net/register/thor0525/evaluations.asp</u>

To claim CME credit, complete these four steps:

- 1. Attend the CME-eligible activity. The designation of AMA PRA Category 1 Credits™ is listed in the conference program for applicable sessions.

- 3. **Complete a short evaluation for each session(s) for which you desire credit**. Attendance alone is not sufficient.
- 4. Complete a short ATS Conference-wide evaluation.
- 5. Attest to the credits earned through the activity and print your certificate. Don't forget to save or email yourself a PDF of your certificate for your records.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR CLAIMING MOC POINTS:

Although the pre-test is closed, all is not lost! Feel free to attend as many MOC designated courses as possible to earn the maximum number of MOC points! The pre-test is great but **optional**.

To claim MOC, complete these steps:

- 1. **During ATS 2025**: Attend any MOC designated symposia you are interested in. Except for Post-Graduate Courses, advance registration is not required.
- 2. Follow the steps to claim CME credit as listed above- the link to the site is the same as above!
- 3. After ATS 2025: Take the knowledge-based posttest. Posttests for all MOC-eligible symposia will be available on May 21, 2025 and attendees through Friday, June 27, 2025
